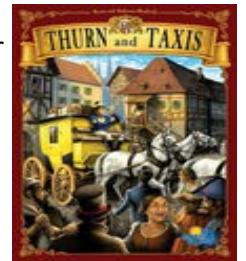

Recipe of the Month: Linsensuppe (from allrecipes.com Canada)

Ingredients

- 2 cups dried brown lentils, rinsed and drained
- 3 cups chicken stock
- 1 bay leaf
- 1 cup chopped carrots
- 1 cup chopped celery
- 1 cup chopped onion
- 1 cup cooked, cubed ham
- 1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/4 teaspoon freshly grated nutmeg
- 5 drops hot pepper sauce
- 1/4 teaspoon caraway seed

- 1/2 teaspoon celery salt
- 1 tablespoon chopped fresh parsley
- 1/2 teaspoon ground black pepper

Directions

Place lentils in a 5 to 6 quart slow cooker. Add chicken stock, bay leaf, carrots, celery, onion, and ham. Season with Worcestershire sauce, garlic powder, nutmeg, hot pepper sauce, caraway seed, celery salt, parsley, and pepper.

Cover, and cook on Low for 8 to 10 hours. Remove bay leaf before serving.

After all the sweets of the holidays, use up leftover ham (or turkey) to make this amazing filling soup (and don't forget to add farmer sausage—a tasty favourite!)

Thomas Mann über „Kunst und Geist“

„Bravo“ rief Settembrini. „Bravo, Leutnant! Sie bezeichnen sehr gut ein unzweifelhaft sittliches Moment im Wesen der Musik, nämlich dieses, dass sie dem Zeitablaufe durch eine ganz eigentümlich lebensvolle Messung Wachheit, Geist und Kostbarkeit verleiht. Die Musik weckt die Zeit, sie weckt uns zum feinsten Genusse der Zeit, sie weckt ... insofern ist sie sittlich. Die Kunst ist sittlich, sofern sie weckt. Aber wie, wenn sie das Gegenteil tut? Wenn sie betäubt, einschläfert, der Aktivität und dem Fortschritt entgegenarbeitet? Auch das kann die Musik, auch auf die Wirkung der Opiate versteht sie sich aus dem Grunde. Eine teuflische Wirkung, meine Herren! Das Opiat ist vom Teufel, denn es schafft Dumpfsinn, Beharrung, Untätigkeit, knechtischen Stillstand ... Es ist etwas Bedenkliches um die Musik, meine Herren. Ich bleibe dabei, dass sie

zweideutigen Wesens ist. Ich gehe nicht zu weit, wenn ich sie für politisch verdächtig erkläre.

Der Zauberberg

Aus einer Rede über das Theater. Zur Eröffnung der Heidelberger Festspiele 1929:

„Was für eine lumpige Zeit, in der wir leben, und welche Lumpen wir, ihre Kinder! Der Mechanismus erstickt die Seele, Geist und Kunst gehen zugrunde, Grammophon, Film, Radio, der sportliche Rekord sind an der barbarischen Tagesordnung, und „dem Chauffeurtypus, das heisst einem entadelten und würdelosen Menschentum“, strebt die Epoche zu. Man liest es, man weiss es, man kann es nicht bestreiten, und man schämt sich der Abendstunden voll niederträchtigen Genusses, die man mit seinem volltönigen Elektrola-Apparat verbrachte, diesem ordinären Zeitgebilde, das einem, ohne dass man sich erst in einer Konzertgarderobe hatte herumstossen lassen müssen, eine Brahms-Sinfonie mit fast ungetrübter Natürlichkeit des Orchesterklanges vortrug.“
